Installation Instructions:

Please read these instructions carefully before installation and make sure you fully understand them. Also, pay attention to how the luminaire is wired. If you require any further guidance, don't hesitate to get in touch with Vertically Urban.

Suspend the VU-ODYSSEY-100 using the most appropriate method for your installation. Below is an example installation using gripple wire to suspend the VU-ODYSSEY-100.





Wiring



WARNING! Risk of electrical shock. Disconnect power before servicing or installation.

Using the junction box on the underside of the VU-ODYSSEY-100, connect to an appropriate AC (200~480Vac) power source power source following the table below. ensure that the cable is suitable for the installation location such as Lapp Ölflex Classic 100 as it provides water and chemical resistance. Always allow sufficient slack not to overstretch the cable. Do not bend the cable beyond its specified bend radius.

Wire Colour	Function
Brown	Live
Blue	Neutral
Green/Yellow	Earth



Ensure that the junction box lid is screwed down correctly and the gland is tightened to preserve IP rating.



Cautions:

PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF LUMINAIRE AND DRIVER INGRESS PROTECTION RATING WHEN DECIDING LOCATION

MAKE SURE ALL CONNECTIONS MADE ARE TIGHT WITH NO LOOSE STRANDS AND WITH AN APPROPRIATE IP RATING.

DO NOT HOT-PLUG, ISOLATE ALL POWER BEFORE ADDING OR REMOVING FITTINGS.

DO NOT REVERSE POLARITY.

ALWAYS ALLOW SUFFICIENT SLACK ON THE SUPPLY CABLE TO REMOVE THE LUMINAIRE FROM ITS
POSITION FOR ANY FURTHER MAINTENANCE

MAKE SURE THE SUPPLY CABLE IS NOT IN CONTACT WITH ANY SHARP OBJECTS; DO NOT LEAVE THE CABLE OR ANY CONNECTOR EXPOSED TO RAIN/MOISTURE FOR ANY PERIOD.
